Antihistamine - Antiallergic Cetirizine 10 mg



FORMULA

Every tablet of 500 mg contains:

Cetirizine.....10,00 mg

Excipients q.s.

DESCRIPTION

ALERGIL PET is an antihistamine agent to inhibit Histamine H1 receptors. It has a direct inhibiting effect on histamine production during allergic processes. It is presented in scored tablets that facilitate its dosage.

INDICATIONS

It seems to be effective to treat histamine-mediated pruritus in dogs and cats.

It also seems to be useful in the treatment of non-reactive chronic rhinosinusitis and eosinophilic skin diseases in cats.

TARGET SPECIES

Dogs and cats.

ADMINISTRATION

Oral route.





DOSAGE

Dogs:

For allergic dermatitis treatment in dogs, one tablet of 500 mg (of 10 mg of cetirizine) is recommended every 10 kg BW every 24 or 12 hours (the dosage judgement depends on the veterinarian's responsibility).

Cats:

For chronic rhinosinusitis and eosinophilic dermatopathies treatments in cats, 1/2 tablet of 500 mg (10 mg of cetirizine) every 12 hours is recommended.

For pruritus treatment, 1/2 tablet of 500 mg (10 mg of cetirizine) is recommended every 24 hours.

CONTRAINDICATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS ON USE

Do not use in patients that are hypersensitive to the active substance or to other antihistamines.

The simultaneous use with depressants of the C.N.S (Central Nervous System) can enhance depressant effects on it.
